

# GENERAL INFORMATION

ANY DAMAGES sustained to CRE Property by exhibitors not following directions will be the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor. Any doors on the building that are propped open will be closed on you. Exhibitor's will be billed accordingly for any damages to doors because they were propped open or mishandled.

## Show Marshals:

Show Marshals will be onsite on Friday & Saturday for show duties. Please follow any instructions given to you from the Show Marshals.

## Substitutions/Scratches:

Show animals can be substituted until 8:00pm on move-in (January 23rd). Please notify the show office as soon as possible if a show animal(s) is being pulled out of an entered class.

## Clipping:

**Please be advised that NO CLIPPING CHUTES can be set up in the main arena unless set up in your own stall space. No chutes in the aisles! Clipping Chute's must be set up in Barn B – wash rack/lean to area ONLY! Just keep in mind you must be back in your stalls by 9:00am Friday & Saturday morning.**

## Official CBC Photographer:

Show Champions is the official CBC photographer. All photos are property of Canadian Bull Congress (CBC). CBC reserves the right to use any photos for marketing & promotional purposes. Exhibitors will be able to purchase photos directly from Show Champions – photos are not available from CBC. Vision Credit Union will be supplying all Grand/Reserve Champions with their winning photos once available from Show Champions.

## Unofficial CBC Photographer:

Terry Pederson will also be onsite taking photos/videos of the event for CBC marketing promotions. All exhibitors will be required to sign a release form at the show office.

## Canadian Bull Congress Marketing Award:

All private breeders are eligible for this award. The judging is done by a select panel with the criteria being: Stall Presentation, Customer Service and Marketing. The award will be presented in the Canadian Bull Congress Show Ring on Saturday with photos.

## Morand Draw:

All private breeders are entered into the draw. Draw will take place on Saturday and the prize must be accepted as awarded and there is NO EXCHANGE OF PRIZE or cash in lieu. The winner must take delivery of the prize at CBC 2020 and is responsible to have it removed from CRE in accordance with move-out times. If necessary, a later pick up time sometimes can be arranged with the show office.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

**A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY has been implemented.** Should any rules and or regulations (as well as pertinent information in the detailed confirmation sent/or any prior emails to you) be disregarded or any disrespect towards CBC Advisory Committee, Volunteers, CRE Staff or its agents, may result in immediate expulsion/eviction from the show/buildings.

**4-H/JR Exhibitors** are bound by all Canadian Bull Congress rules and regulations.

**4-H/JR Stalls are allocated in the main arena, and tagged accordingly.** Animals must be tied in those allocated stalls. Designated tack and chute space has been tagged for these exhibitors and is not for Private Breeder use.

**4-H Showmanship Class.** All members entered in the 4-H Heifer show will be automatically entered into the 4-H Showmanship Class. No Entry Fee. Members will advance to the showmanship finals from the confirmation class.

**Additional gates will be opened on Saturday for move-out, as well tie-outs will be opened for move-out – PLEASE REFER TO MAP!** Please check with CRE operations staff/Barn Boss as to “logistics” of tie-outs for move-out.

**ALL cattle must be out of the building by 7:00pm on Saturday.** If you have made arrangements with the show office to have cattle stay over they must be taken to Barn B (not tie-outs) by 7:00pm.

**Tear Down will begin when the show ends at 5:00pm on Saturday, January 25th.** There will be no take down prior to 5:00pm. Large Trade Show Exhibitors please be advised you will not be loaded until CRE Operations deem it safe to load out which could be between 7:00 – 8:00pm.

**Clipping/Fitting** is allowed in the shows.

**NO SMOKING** in any CRE Building or in the Tie out Area.

**NO DOGS** allowed in the facility.

**Manure should be thrown in the appropriate Manure Bin and not in the Garbage Bins.** Garbage should be thrown in the appropriate Garbage Bin.

## **NEWS – NOTICES – REGULATION UPDATES 2020**

**It is important that the information contained within, should be shared with anyone working in your stall/booth.**

**Have your exhibitor tags with you at all times and your parking pass displayed on your dash! Security and Night Watchmen are doing their jobs as defined by the Canadian Bull Congress Committee so when they ask for tags, please do so respectfully and without question!**

**Exhibitor Tags/Parking passes were allotted in your package.**

You need your tags to gain access to the buildings. If accessing through the main doors you will be charged admission if you cannot produce your exhibitor tags. Additional passes can be purchased from the show office for \$5.00/Tag. Exhibitors parking behind the Event Centre must show their parking pass to Gate Security.

**The Barn Boss & Assistant Barn Boss** will be readily identifiable to exhibitors and shall be the person(s) who will handle all exhibitors' inquiries, disputes, vet calls, etc. They are in charge of the building and exhibitors for the event and will refer to the committee only if deemed necessary.

**Cattle Walkways, Overnight Tie-Outs – Only cattle, cattle exhibitors and authorized personnel will be allowed through the cattle/tie-out doors.** For those of you who purchased OUTSIDE TIE-OUTS, they are all tagged accordingly. Please ensure you are in your allocated space. There is a designated manure area in the Outside Tie-Outs. **\*\*\*ALL CATTLE IN TIE-OUTS IT IS MANDATORY TO HAVE NECK ROPES!**

**Night Watchmen will be onsite Thursday & Friday evening for tie-outs.** Please have your exhibitor passes available for watch men to verify access to tie-outs after the buildings have been locked (11:00pm to 5:00am). Night Watchmen will have access to new neck ropes and CBC will charge exhibitors a \$25 FEE if they are utilized.

**Security** will be onsite starting Thursday and continuing 24 hour coverage until Saturday at 5:00pm. Please have your exhibitor tags on you as they will be checking tags of exhibitors entering through the back doors/after hours. If an exhibitor's pass CANNOT be produced, access will be denied to the facility!

**All Exhibitors must be out of the buildings by 11:00pm** on Thursday and Friday so the building can be properly secured. (Exceptions will be made only through permission granted by the Barn Boss or Assistant Barn Boss).

Specific doors will be opened at 5:00am for access into the building (one by the wash rack, one by the tented walkway). **If you need to be here before 5:00am either day**, you should knock loudly on the door by the wash rack and have your exhibitor badges ready for inspection.

Day Shift Security will be onsite Friday & Saturday manning the back gate so **please ensure you have your parking pass for entry behind the building.**

**Any issues with security will be reported to the Barn Boss and dealt with accordingly.**

Camrose County Move-in Day will be providing coffee/cookies for exhibitors on Thursday! **Don't forget about the Exhibitors & Sponsors Reception Thursday evening in the Garden Court starting at 6:30 and running until 9:30pm.**

Exhibitors are responsible to comply with the Alberta Liquor & Gaming Act at all times. Drinking is permitted in licensed areas only (Exhibitor's Social, Taste of Beef Banquet and the Lounge located in the Garden Court). There will be NO EXCEPTIONS! No Outside Alcohol will be allowed and Security will confiscate any outside alcohol found. **The CBC Lounge will be located in the Garden Court beside the Concession and will be open daily.** The lounge is open to the general public.

**The Camrose County Show Ring will be located in Barn B.** Access to the Camrose County Show Ring is marked accordingly. Please use the designated cattle alley – no cattle through the covered public access walkway. Barn B also is the location for the wash/clipping area. **Exhibitors with Triple Crown Entries and Bull-Nanza Entries will be confirmed by the Barn Bosses to ensure all entries submitted are compliant with the rules.**

**The Official Canadian Bull Congress veterinarian is Dr. J. Whiting, D.M.V.** The vet will be onsite to inspect the cattle in the building. Any exhibitor requiring vet services must contact the Barn Boss first so they can coordinate contacting the vet for immediate assistance.
